The Torrington City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, December 1st, 2015 in the City Council Chambers at 436 East 22nd Ave. at 7:00 p.m. Present: Mayor Varney, Council Members Adams, Hill, Kelly and Law. Also Present: Clerk/Treasurer Strecker, Attorney Eddington, Chief of Police Sharp, Engineer Juve, and Water/Wastewater Supervisor Troxel.

Mayor Varney called the meeting to order.

Chaplain Jill Bryan led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Varney commented the City received a letter from the Embassy of the People's Republic of Bangladesh. It stated they are concerned about initiatives that are being taken to name streets, roads, and parts of cities and towns in the USA after Major General Ziaur Rahman who in 1977 unlawfully seized power in Bangladesh. They stated to honor a ruthless military dictator is against democracy and liberalism that both countries uphold so dearly. The Bangladesh government is concerned when honor is shown to Ziaur Rahman it amounts to endorsing extremism and terrorism, which are at present creating havoc all across the world, and requested any plans to commemorate such a cruel dictator as Ziaur Rahman be avoided.

Mayor Varney commented on a Star Herald newspaper article that stated the Environmental Protection Agency issued a final rule designed to increase production of ethanol to be blended with gasoline through 2016. He felt this might increase interest to re-open the Torrington Ethanol Plant.

Councilman Kelly moved and Councilman Adams seconded to approve the consent agenda which includes the minutes of the 11-17-15 Council meeting as published and all actions therein be ratified. Motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Law moved and Councilwoman Hill seconded to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Councilwoman Hill moved and Councilman Kelly seconded the designation of Councilman Adams as the voting delegate, Mayor Varney as the alternate, and Councilman Law as the second alternate for the 2016 WAM Winter Workshop in February. Motion carried unanimously.

Engineer Juve presented for approval a joint resolution to submit an application to SLIB for County Wide Consensus Block Grant Funds for BFY 15/16 funding in the amount of \$369,892. The funds will be used for a Water Line Replacement project for portions of Hwy 26 and W. A. to W.B. St. for \$125,000, an Industrial Park Utility Expansion to Lot 4 for \$122,097, a Sewer Relocation/Rehab Hwy 26 project for \$72,795, and Street Improvements on 24th Ave. near Hillcrest for \$50,000. Councilman Adams moved and Councilman Kelly seconded to approve Joint Resolution No. 2015-28 as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

The bills from 11-18-15 to 12-01-15 were presented for payment. Councilman Law moved and Councilwoman Hill seconded to approve the bills for payment as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Varney congratulated Golf Pro Dent on the recent birth of a grandson and Museum Director Chaires on the birth of a daughter.

Councilwoman Hill moved and Councilman Kelly seconded that there being no further business to come before the Council to adjourn at 7:27 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
